Looking to utilize the property purchased. Want to move CannaBash concert series to Baldwin. Wanting to do something for Blessing of the Bikes, and possibly do smaller concert events during summer weekends and bring in local acts.

Connie Sparrow: CannaBash

Muskegon township has been the home of CannaBash last two years. CannaBash is a public licensed consumption event.

First year had 6,800 attendees and headlined by Bone Thugs-N-Harmony. Second year had 12,000 attendees and headlined by Ludacris.

60% attendees had never been to a licensed consumption event. 56% attendees were from out of state.

Goal would be to have 6 2,500-3,000-person summer concerts have CannaBash, cap at 13,000. Blessing of the Bikes event to be 5,500-7,000-person event.

Only do Food trucks and music, with vendors on-site.

Predict \$2.7 million sales of alcohol, cannabis, merch, tickets, and food.
